LAS VEGAS – (July XX, 2025) – [FAS44 \(Freyboy Art Salon\)](#) is proud to host renowned photographer and multidisciplinary artist [Isaac “Drift” Wright](#) for his first Las Vegas exhibit, **“Coming Home,”** opening Thursday, Sept. 18 through Saturday, Oct. 25. Known globally for his breathtaking, gravity-defying images captured from some of the highest and most iconic points around the world, Drift, for the first time, brings his lens to the heart of the Las Vegas arts and culture scene.

The announcement of the exhibit is on the heels of a recent *New York Times* profile by Pulitzer Prize-winning journalist David Phillips, titled *“He Spent Decades Behind Bars for His Art: Now, He Has a Show in N.Y.C.”* The article traces Wright’s remarkable journey from military service to incarceration and, ultimately, his emergence as one of the most distinctive and daring urban photographers to-date.

In collaboration with NYC-based [Robert Mann Gallery](#), *“Coming Home”* invites viewers to experience a powerful visual narrative of resilience, rebellion and redemption, and features 16 large-scale photographic prints captured from extraordinary vantage points, including the Golden Gate Bridge, the Empire State Building, and Christ the Redeemer in Rio de Janeiro. Each work in the exhibit will be available for purchase, offering collectors a chance to own part of Wright’s visceral exploration of height, risk and perspective. Wright’s critically acclaimed coffee table book, *“It Was Never Dark,”* will also be available for purchase at the venue.

As part of the limited exhibit engagement, Wright will graciously donate one of his works for a raffle, where 100% of proceeds from ticket sales will directly benefit the [Public Education Foundation](#). In addition, Wright and FAS44 will donate a portion of proceeds from his coffee table book sales to the organization.
